All organizations will refer veterans to the contact person listed at the bottom of this notice. The veterans will then be contacted individually, to set up an evaluation appointment to determine what services need to be done. Over twenty veterans will be able to be served at this event and the list will be compiled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Who: Any veteran living in Minnesota

What: Each veteran will need a list of prescribed medications and/or over-the-counter medication they are taking, and bring a military ID. Dental patient forms will be sent to the veteran to fill out. All of this information should be brought to the evaluation appointment.
